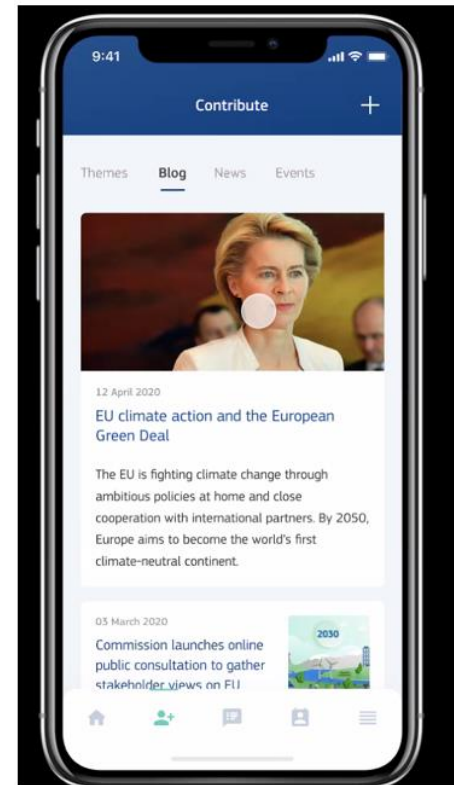
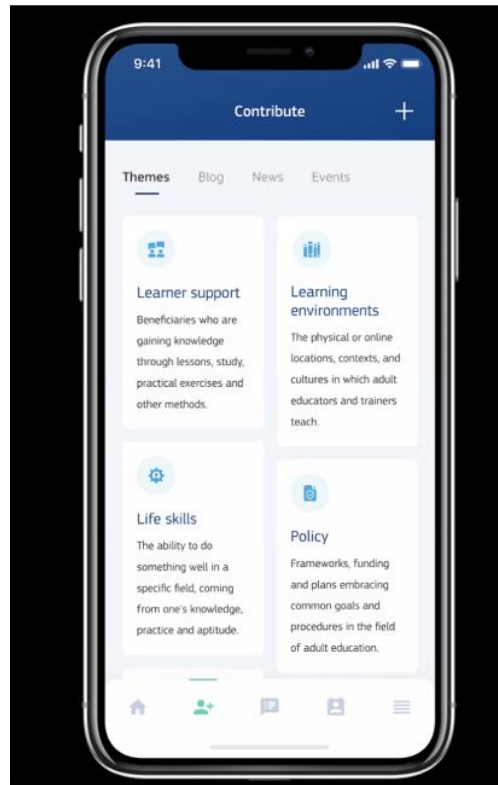

Priorities and themes 2022-2024



- EPALE activities are also expected to contribute to the overall **priorities** of the Erasmus+ programme, notably **inclusion and diversity, digital transformation, environment and fight against climate change** and participation in democratic life.
- Specific **thematic focuses will be defined for every calendar year** of the contractual period, i.e. for 2022, 2023 and 2024.
- EPALE will support the policy priorities for adult learning set forth in the European Pillar of Social Rights and its Action Plan, the European Skills Agenda and the **forthcoming New European Agenda for Adult Learning**.

Education towards sustainability

Four years project (2021-2024)

Goal: To form a cooperation network to coordinate education towards sustainability at all levels of education (from pre-primary to adult)

- make a survey of the present situation in each country
- develop Nordic learning outcomes where all student-teachers learn to make sustainability an integrated part of their teaching, whether to children or adults
- produce Nordic learning material for different education levels and offering it free of charge

- 2021-2024 Management of funds for teacher training networks
- 2022: Norwegian presidency policy conference on teachers' competences
- 2023: Nordic Youth Summit in Iceland
